Aleona became a DAC Champion last weekend, winning the 800 Meter Run in a career best time of 2:19.37. She also placed second in the 1500 with another career best of 4:48.71, placed 6th in the Pole Vault with a mark of 8' 2 ¼", and scored an addition point for the team with an 8th place finish in the Heptathlon with 3200 points. Aleona scored 21.5 points for the Jimmie team, helping them to a second place finish at the DAC Outdoor Championships.

Sarah scored 4657 points to eclipse her previous record by 15 points. Sarah won the high jump, 100 hurdles (14.98), long jump (17' 5 ½"), and 200 (25.60) on her way to the title. Sarah is currently ranked 8th in the NAIA in the heptathlon.
